„Schoppen“ is a lost handicraft. „Schopper“ built big wooden barges (boats) for the transportation of goods on the Danube. The “Schopperplatz” in Aschach is a historical manufacturing site for Danube barges. Situated directly on the Danube, behind the “Schopper” museum, this area offers us an exciting and exceptional area for the First European Ural Meeting. The “Schopperplatz” is ideal for the start of the Ural Rallye. We can use the area also for camping. The Danube still has about 20° C and is nice for bathing.

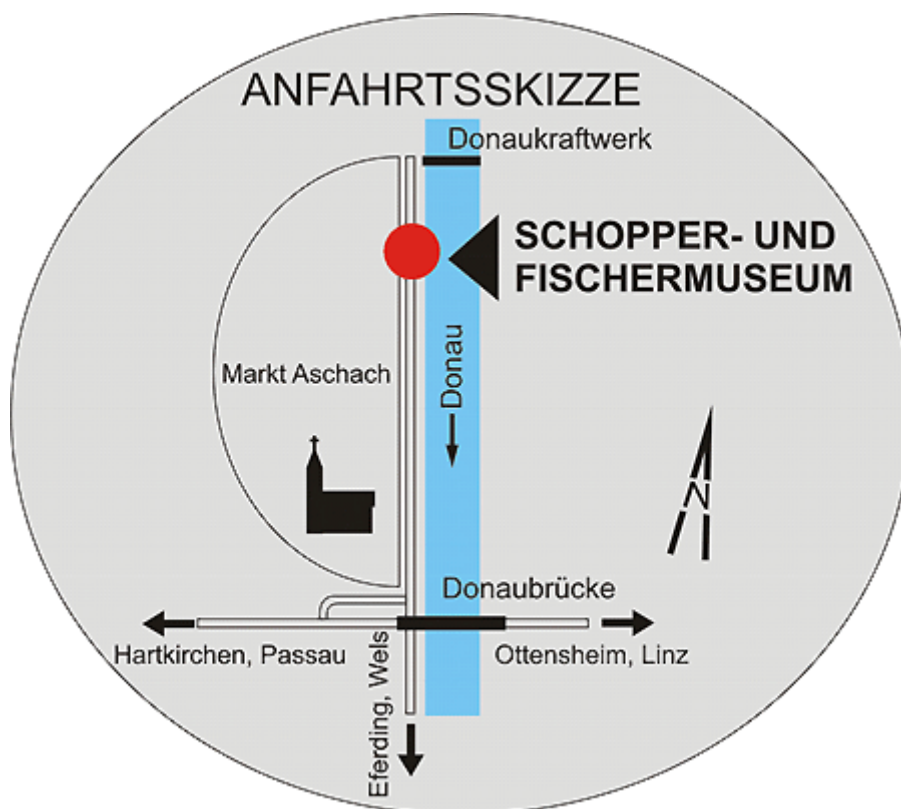
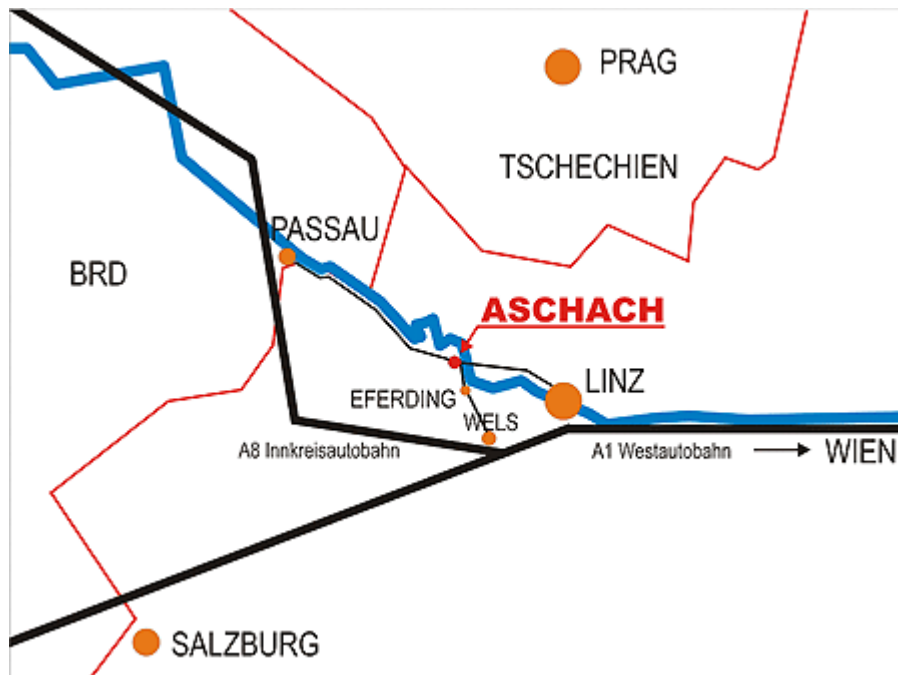
We are really looking forward to welcoming you all and wish you a nice journey to Aschach.
